

RULES FOR MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

The journal *AVTOMATIKA I VYCHISLITEL'NAYA TEKHNIKA (AVT)* is published in Russian by Institute of Electronics and Computer Sciences. This journal is translated into English and with the title *AUTOMATIC CONTROL AND COMPUTER SCIENCES (AC&CS)* is published by ALLERTON PRESS, INC., New York, USA. (<http://www.allertonpress.com/journals/aut.htm>).

AVT Edition receives for considering articles in Russian.

The articles that match to *AVT* areas and which had never been published before, are accepted by Edition to consideration. Costs for publication are paid by Edition, but authors transmit to the Publisher free exclusive rights to publication of their articles, that does not infringe inalienable copyrights (an item 13 Laws of the Latvian Republic "About the copyright and the collateral right").

Structure of the manuscript:

- Formulation should be unequivocal, arguments – convincing.
- The text of the manuscript should be laconic, a terminology – rigorous, generally known.
- **Abstract:** brief formulation of the basic contents of article – no more than 10 lines.
- **Introduction:** the substantiation of a urgency, comparison to researches of other authors.
- **Sections:** precise statement of a problem and an exposition of the basic contents of the publication.
- **Conclusion:** the brief description of practical advantage and efficiency of the research results.
- **Bibliography:** numbering of references should correspond to sequence of their mention in the text of the article: [1], [2],....
- **Layout:** the size of a font – 14, the desirable font – TimesNewRoman, volume – no more than 15 pages of format A4 (including figures and tables) with listing the text through 2 intervals.
- **Transfer of the manuscript** (file in Microsoft Word for Windows) can be made through E-mail (avt@edi.lv) as Attachment.
- **On the first page are placed:** the title of the article, the initials and surnames of authors with the mention of academic status and degrees, the title of organization and its address, E-mail of authors, the summary (no more than 60 words), key words.
- **Figures:** in formats JPG or GIF (or BMP, PCX...).
- Formulas to print in separate lines, numbers to appropriate to all formulas. All symbols should have explanations.
- It is desirable to not use abbreviations, exception – the generally known abbreviations.
- Applied terms should be unequivocal. To not use a professional slang.
